Key question: Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?

### Key Knowledge:

#### **To know that...**

- ⇒ **Lent remembers the time when Jesus went into the wilderness for 40 days.**
- ⇒ **Good Friday is when Jesus was crucified on a cross**
- ⇒ **Easter Sunday is when Jesus was resurrected.**
- ⇒ Jesus went to the wilderness to prepare for sacrificing Himself on the cross.
- ⇒ Christians give things up during Lent to make their own sacrifices like Jesus.
- ⇒ Shrove Tuesday (Pancake day) is the day that Christians use up all their sugar/fat/ flour in readiness for Lent .
- ⇒ Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent.
- ⇒ Maundy Thursday was the Last Supper when Judas betrayed Jesus with a kiss.
- ⇒ Easter Sunday is when Lent finishes.
- ⇒ Christians attend church services at this time of year to remember these special days.



### Key Vocabulary:

**Salvation:** being a saviour or rescuer of others: 'Jesus, our salvation'

**Easter:** the Holy time when Christians remember Jesus' death and resurrection

**Holy Week:** the last week of Jesus' life where key events happened

**Palm Sunday:** the Sunday before Easter, on which Christ's entry into Jerusalem

**Maundy Thursday:** the fifth day of Holy Week which remembers the Last Supper.

**Holy Communion:** the act of taking bread and wine to remind us of Jesus

**The Last Supper:** the last meal Jesus shared with his disciples

**Garden of Gethsemane:** the garden where Jesus was praying when he was arrested

**Jerusalem:** the Holy City for Christians where Jesus arrived on a donkey

**Disciples:** a follower of Jesus.

**Betrayal:** an act of deliberate disloyalty or breaking someone's trust.
