Key Vocabulary:

Old Testament - the first half of the Christian Bible that is also found in the Jewish Torah Scroll.

New Testament—the second half of the Bible, written after Jesus' death **Books**— The Bible is made up of 66 books (King James' Bible has 80)

Chapter—a part of a book which is indicated by a large number

Psalms—a sacred song or hymn

Prayer—a request of help or an expression of thanks to a god

Verse—a part of a chapter which is indicated by a small number **Commandments** –Laws given to Christians to follow from God

Humanists – people who place a greater importance on humans rather than on religion

Worship—express faith upon a god
