### Key Knowledge:

#### To know that:

- Pattern phrases (spotty, stripy, checked) will always come at the end after the item of clothing and its colour
- 'Quand' means 'when' e.g. Quand il fait beau, je porte ...
- 'Je mets / je porte' means 'I wear'
- Some nouns are singular in French e.g. un pantalon, un jean, un short but translate into plural English nouns e.g. trousers, jeans, shorts
- 'Des' means 'some' (the partitive article) and shows that there is more than one noun e.g. des bottes—some boots
- When using a bi-lingual dictionary, word class and examples will help you choose the correct French word when there is more than one translation.
