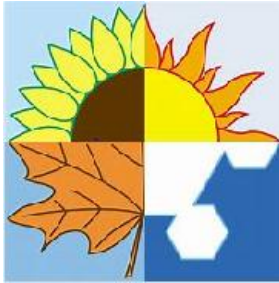

Key Knowledge:

To know that:

- ▷ **When used with weather, 'il fait' means 'it is' (not it does) e.g il fait du soleil - it is sunny**
- ▷ **'Quelquefois' means 'sometimes'; 'souvent' means 'often'.**
- ▷ **Locations and the seasons can be used as fronted adverbials when discussing the weather e.g. au printemps—in Spring**
- ▷ You can put two types of weather together by using the conjunctions 'et' and/or 'mais'
- ▷ One way of forming a question is by inverting the subject and verb e.g Quel temps fait-il?
- ▷ Always use the word à before a town i.e à Poole, to describe in which town the weather is
