PE KIT & TIMETABLE

For all PE lessons children are required to wear the school's PE kit;

- ✓ PE t-shirt in 'house' colour with school crest
- ✓ Black shorts or jogging bottoms
- ✓ Red school fleece with school crest *
- ✓ Suitable outdoor trainers
- ✓ Earrings removed or taped

* Our red school fleece is to be worn only for PE or, if needed, on top of jumper/ cardigan in class if cold. We consider the fleece to be an additional layer when children are in uniform - they are not to be worn instead of a jumper/cardigan.

On their PE days, children are expected to arrive at school already wearing their PE kit. They will not be required to change after their PE lesson but will instead stay dressed in their PE kit all day.

All earrings should be removed during PE lessons; if children are unable to remove their earrings, they are required to cover them with micropore tape (provided by themselves) to avoid them becoming caught.

All hair, shoulder-length or longer, should be tied up at all times during school.

PE AND SPORTS PREMIUM

Since 2013, primary aged schools have received an annual 'PE and Sports Premium' which is a ring-fenced allocation of money to improve the provision of physical education, school sport and physical activity (PESSPA) in schools.

SPORTS COMPETITIONS/FIXTURES/FESTIVALS/EVENTS

Last academic year (2024/25), we attended 137 sports/physical activity events with 2923 'spaces' created for children to participate in these events.

The aim of school sport at Baden-Powell and St Peter's CE Junior School is to 'deeply enrich the four year experience that all pupils have at the school whilst maintaining and building upon our competitive reputation'. We aim to do this by offering a broad, extensive and innovative sports and events programme for as many pupils as possible. Our sports and events programme consists of all following avenues;

Each sporting event applies to one or multiple categories which are stated in the table below. The table also stipulates which group of children are invited to each event.



Category	Selecting Participants
Competitive	Children with the highest attainment and ability in the relevant area(s) of PE/sport are invited.
Development	Children are chosen who have an interest in the event and/or those that could development their interests and attainment.
Targeted	Children are invited based upon those that are currently disengaged with regular physical activity/sport inside and/or outside of school.
Special Educational Needs & Disabilities (SEND)	Children are selected based upon those who have special educational needs or disabilities.



For each sporting event that your child is invited to, you will be notified of this via email from the school office. On average, this invite will be sent 30 days prior to the date of the event, however, if there is a postponement or rearrangement, the invite to parents/carers may be less than 30 days prior to the event taking place.

We have the following school sports teams who aim to represent our school in ‘competitive’ category events, such as those organised by the Poole and East Dorset School Sports Association, Dorset Schools Football Association and other organisations with a focus on competition.

- ✓ Year 5 and 6 – Boys Football Team
- ✓ Year 5 and 6 – Girls Football Team
- ✓ Year 5 and 6 – Mixed Netball Team
- ✓ Year 5 and 6 – Mixed Cross-Country Team
- ✓ Year 5 and 6 – Swimming and Swimming Relay Teams

For the Year 5 and 6 boys and girls football teams, children are selected based upon open football trial sessions which take place at the beginning of each academic year. The Year 5 and 6 swimming teams are also selected based upon a swimming trial which happens in January each academic year. For the Year 5 and 6 mixed netball and cross-country teams, children are selected based upon performances in inter house sports competitions and/or PE lessons.

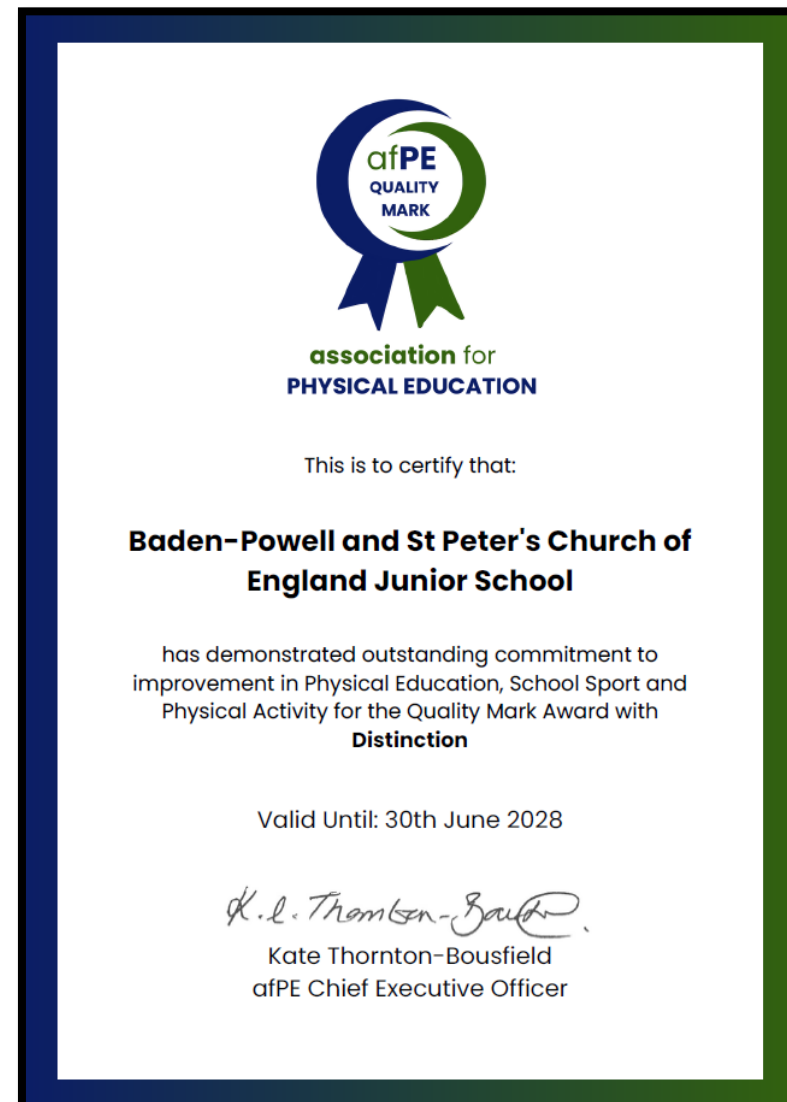
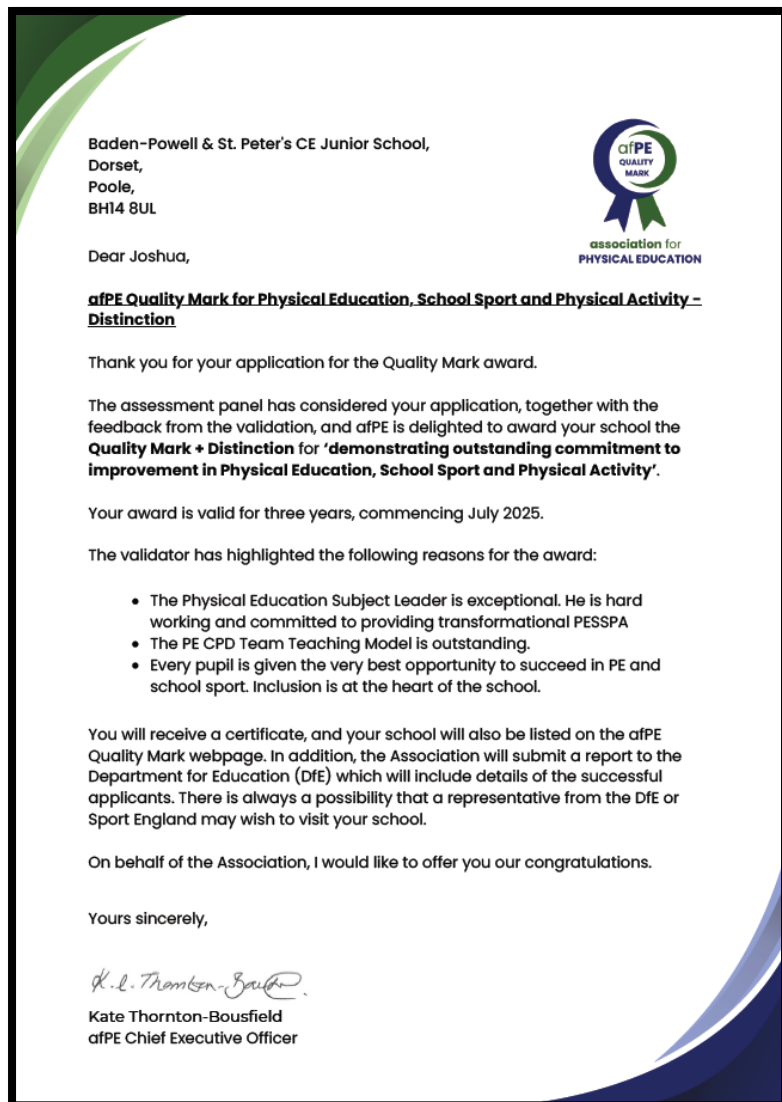
