## Extra-Curricular Clubs – Summer 2026

Please see below information regarding clubs for the Summer 2026 term. Listed at the end of this letter are details for each of the clubs including how to sign up for clubs plus information regarding payment. Please note the continuation of dismissal arrangements from extra-curricular clubs – details are below.

- **No clubs take place first or last week of term. Clubs start w/c Monday 20 April 2026 and finish w/e Friday 17 July 2026 unless indicated below.**
- Children will have access to the changing rooms (they will continue to wear PE kit into school on their Games/PE days). Therefore, if they have a sports club or Forest Club after school they will need to wear their uniform into school on that day and bring their PE kit to change into after school. Please ensure that all uniform and kit is NAMED.
- Football Clubs – children will change into their football boots outside and then leave their bags under the bike shelters. Please read the notes on CASA website regarding football boots.
- Even if it is raining, outdoor clubs will stay outside whenever possible – please **do not** sign your child up for a club if you (or they!) don't wish for them be outside when it is cold and wet, or if they don't have appropriate clothing for inclement weather. Unless the weather forecast is severe enough to compromise everyone's safety, the clubs will be held in their preferred location - refunds will not be offered if alternative indoor activities need to take place due to the weather.
- We will assume your child will attend their club each week. If your child is not able to attend a session, please let the office know, in good time, by email or phone and make sure your child is aware of the arrangements before they come into school.
- **Collection after clubs. All after-school clubs finish at 4.30pm** (except for Ukulele). To continue the safeguarding measures we have put in place when dismissing the children at the end of the school day, please complete the **online form** to let us know if you are happy for your child to leave their club by themselves or whether you will be collecting them from the teacher/coach (default option will be collecting from club onsite unless you advise otherwise via completion of the form). If you chose for your child to leave by themselves, please could we ask that you check your child is aware of their collection arrangements and where they are to meet you – we would also ask you to remind them to return to the school office if they cannot find the person collecting them, or if they are at all unsure of their arrangements. Locations/school building exits for dismissal from clubs will be listed on the attached spreadsheet.
- It is important that you have discussed the nature of the club with your son/daughter and that they have expressed a genuine interest in attending it. The clubs should not be used for childcare provision as this is unfair on your child, the other club members and the adults in charge.

## SIGNING UP & REGISTRATION

- Booking systems for external-led clubs are run by the coaches/companies themselves – BPSP has no control over their set-up or timings for reservations and payments.
- For BPSP teacher-led Summer clubs please see individual club details below as to whether the attendee list will be carried over from the Spring term, or places will be offered to waiting list first or if there will be new sign-ups.
- For BPSP teacher-led clubs that carry over the attendee list or offered to waiting list, please confirm your

child's place (and make payment, if applicable) for the Spring term by **midday on Friday 20 March**. Any unconfirmed places after this date may be offered to children on the waiting list.

- New sign-up clubs that are applied for online via Arbor will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Bookings for clubs on Arbor will open (and close) as follows:**
  - **Open 6.00pm on Sunday 15 March 2026 for Yr 3 & 4 clubs**
  - **Open 6.30pm on Sunday 15 March 2026 for Yr 5 & 6 clubs**
  - **All club Arbor bookings will close on midday on Monday 13 April 2026.**
  - **For information, Kids' Haven bookings will open at 6.00pm on Monday 16 March 2026.**
- For clubs applied for via Arbor, if you cannot see the relevant club, or the system stops you from completing the booking, then unfortunately it means that club is fully booked. Please complete the [online form](#) to be added to the new term's waiting list (please do not email the school). Form will open at 6.00pm Sunday 15 March 2026.
- Please note that Arbor often struggles with many simultaneous bookings taking place when the system opens and parents can often get part-way through the process of booking a place at the same time the club has become full. Depending on whether this is a paid or free club, it might then freeze at a different stage. However, parents tend to find that the system will get 'stuck' at the 'Select Membership Periods' drop-down box - this means the club is full.
- **For any clubs that require payment to be made via Arbor: please note that if you don't make payment at the time of requesting participation, you may lose the place.** Pupils will only become a member of the club when you have paid. If you select the club and then return to pay later, and the maximum number of students have already signed up (and paid) you will have missed your chance to secure a space in the club.
- Registers will be taken at the beginning of each session. **It is your responsibility to inform the school office if your child will not be attending their club.**
- Places will be offered on condition that children's behaviour is always good. Places can be withdrawn if teachers/coaches have concerns about behaviour. No refunds will be given.
- If your child consistently fails to attend a club, their place may be withdrawn and re-allocated. If your child no longer wishes to take part in their club, please notify the office so their place can be offered to someone on the waiting list. No refunds will be given.
- If a club does need to be cancelled, we will do our best to give 24 hours' notice. The School Office will inform you by email/text. Please make sure you keep the Office updated of any changes in contact details.
