Annual School Report and Parent/Teacher Consultations – Spring Term 2026

SCHOOL REPORTS

Your child's main school report will be available to view via DC Pro from approximately 3.30pm on Friday 13 March. Year 3 parents, and parents of any child new to the school, were issued DC Pro login details on Monday 9 March. For the remainder of the school, please ensure that you have your existing log in details in order to access your child's report online. Please contact the school office if you require further assistance.

We hope you'll find the report both a celebration of your child's progress and achievements so far this year as well as informative in terms of their next steps.

The report provides the following information:

- **Class teacher summary** - a commentary to your child as a learner and their performance so far this year.
- **Reading, Writing and Maths** - your child's attainment measured against national expectations. There is also an attitude to learning grade, which is explained in more detail within the report.
- **Foundation subjects** - your child's attainment and attitude to learning across the curriculum.

For the parents of children in 5SP, prior to leaving BPSP at Christmas, Mrs Eaton liaised closely with Mrs Parkes regarding the children's progress in the Autumn term. This has been considered when composing the children's school report.

Assessment grading for Reading, Writing and Maths:

Your child's attainment grade is based on the teacher's ongoing assessment of your child's learning, taking into account day-to-day progress in lessons as well as the results of formal testing. An explanation of these can be found within the report and teacher comments in the report will expand on these judgements.

Attendance:

The pie chart indicates your child's overall attendance levels up to and including Friday 13 March. In general, we encourage an attendance level of at least 96% from our children so that they are able to benefit fully from their education.

PARENT / TEACHER CONSULTATIONS

Should there be any areas of concern following the receipt of your child's report you are welcome to book a Parent/Teacher Consultation via Arbor. As previously, we are giving parents and carers the choice of a face to face or telephone appointment. Should you wish to be contacted by phone, it is essential that you include your name and preferred telephone number in the notes section when booking your appointment.

Parents' evenings are scheduled for the following days:

- **Tuesday 24 March (3.30-6.30pm)** – these will be with class teachers only (they will also make comments on maths if they are your child's maths teacher). 10-minute appointments.
- **Monday 20 April (3.30-4.30pm)** – these will be with your child's Maths Teacher (for Years 5 and 6 - only available to book if your child's maths teacher is different to their class teacher). 5-minute appointments.

Please access our online booking system using your Arbor account (select 'Guardian Consultations'). You will then be able to see available appointments for your child's class teacher and, if appropriate, their Maths teacher also. The booking system will **open at 6.00pm on Friday 13 March** and close at midday on Wednesday 18 March 2026 for class teachers and midday on Friday 17 April for Maths teachers.

Alternatively, you are welcome to acknowledge receipt of your child's report, and also provide feedback, via this [online form](#) (form will close at midday on Friday 27 March) or by printing the relevant page of the report and returning to school.


