Dear Parents/Carers

Easter Service – Wednesday 25 March 2026

The whole school will be going to St. Peter's Church on Wednesday 25 March to celebrate our Easter Service. Our trip to the church can only happen with parent support so any help from willing volunteers will be very much appreciated! Our risk assessment for this trip requires us to have three adults accompanying each class on the walk to and from the church. Please indicate via this [online form](#) if you are able to help by 9.00am Friday 20 March.

Volunteers will need to be at school by 10.05am. This will allow us time to go through the risk assessment prior to heading to church at 10.20am. We will begin walking back immediately after the service around 11.40am. If you are not staying for the service, please be at the church by 11.30am to walk the children back to school.

Regrettably, due to updated fire regulations at St Peter's Church, we are no longer able to accommodate all parents and carers in addition to the children for this special event. There is now a limit on the number of people allowed to occupy the church at any given time, and we are required to ensure that all access points remain clear for safety. This means that, while we can still invite parents who are volunteering or walking children to the church to attend, we can no longer invite all parents to join us for the Easter service as we had originally hoped. We understand that this may prompt a large number of responses for volunteering and apologise that we may need to turn down some offers of help.

Should the situation change and we are able to adjust our plans, we will notify you as soon as possible. We sincerely appreciate your understanding as we work to keep everyone safe.

It is expected that all children will participate in this whole school occasion and that all parents will consent for the children to walk. Therefore, it is vital that you let us know in writing by Friday 20 March if your child is unable to participate.
