Yr 3 Ancient Technology Centre Trips & Summer Term Activity Week

I am delighted to share our Year 3 Class Trips and information for our Summer Term Activities Week.

Ancient Technology Centre Trips

Two classes will be visiting the ATC, Damerham Road, Cranborne, BH21 5RP each day:

Friday 20 March	3CT and 3HB
Tuesday 24 March	3PY and 3KC
Thursday 26 March	3SW and 3FP

The children should wear warm, comfortable outdoor clothes plus jacket and sturdy boots/trainers. Please can they also wear their school jumper/ fleece. All children are to bring a snack, water bottle and packed lunch (children in receipt of Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch).

We will be travelling to and from the centre by coach, leaving at 9.15am and returning for 3.20pm.

The children will engage in expert-led workshops to experience what life might have been like for a Celt living in Britain.

Summer Term Activity Week (w/c Monday 6 July)

Our theme for the week is: *Into the Woods*.

All activities are planned to be outside in the fresh air using our wonderful, extensive school grounds. We adopt a 'Woodland School' approach to the week with activities including den building, making a bug hotel and doing some giant size artwork.

The children can wear their own clothes each day, however, please ensure their clothes are suitable and appropriate for school, learning and enjoying the outdoors. We strongly recommend long trousers or leggings with a t-shirt / jumper and trainers.

In order for these trips to go ahead and for us to provide the range of activities, we ask for a **voluntary donation of £30.00** payable via Arbor. This above cost includes coach travel to and from Cranborne as well as the work-shops and additional resources for our activity week.
