## Year 6 Residential Trip to New Forest Activities Centre – Summer 2026

We are planning to run a residential trip in the summer term for our Year 6 cohort to the New Forest Activities Centre. Please see the [link](#) for more information about the centre which is located in Beaulieu, in the middle of the New Forest.

The trip will be split across the first week of July. We will divide the cohort depending on the numbers attending in each class. We will be aiming to leave BPSP at 9.30am and returning at 3.00pm

Group 1: Monday 29th June - Wednesday 1st July

Group 2: Wednesday 1st July - Friday 3rd July

During our stay, the children will be provided with 2 nights full board, camping accommodation and take part in a number of activities based around the themes of team building, environmental awareness and outdoor education. The emphasis will be on having fun whilst trying new activities such as canoeing, high ropes courses, team building skills, outdoor survival and the 'battle zone'.

We anticipate that the cost will be in the region of £300 depending on how many pupils decide to participate. The more interest we have, the cheaper the trip! This price will include accommodation, food, activities and transport. For children who are currently eligible for Free School Meals, the school's Charges and Remissions Policy will apply; these families would not be required to pay for the board and lodgings aspect of the trip, which represents a significant reduction in cost. We will contact you separately with this information.

Please complete this [form](#) to accept or decline your child attending and, if accepting, pay the non-refundable deposit of £30 on Arbor by **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November**. Once we have the responses back from every member of Year 6, I will send further information regarding costs and arrangements including a payment plan.

Unfortunately, we are only able to take a maximum of 160 children on this trip (80 per group). Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis of payments received. Bookings will open on Arbor under 'Trips' Y6 Residential Trip at 6pm on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> October.

Please note, you do have the opportunity to change your mind at any time but any monies paid towards the trip are non-refundable.
