Year 6 SATs

As we approach SATs week, we want to take a moment to acknowledge the hard work and dedication your child has shown throughout this academic year. The upcoming Key Stage 2 SATs are an opportunity for our pupils to demonstrate their learning and progress. We understand that this can be a time of mixed emotions, but we are confident that with your continued support, the children will approach the week with confidence and resilience.

Your continued support and encouragement at home is hugely appreciated. In the lead up to the test week and indeed during, it will be an enormous help if the children get plenty of rest; avoid any extreme sports (no injuries, etc.); go to bed at a reasonable hour; have a good breakfast and arrive at school in good time each day. It is also important to promote a positive mindset by reassuring your child that the SATs are just one part of their learning journey, encourage them to do their best and remind them that it's okay to feel nervous.

As you will be aware, the KS2 tests are a statutory requirement and in previous years we've managed a 100% attendance during this week. If your child is too unwell to come into school, please notify the school in the usual way and we will then be in touch with what to do next with regards to rescheduling any tests taken on that day.

The timetable for the week is detailed below. Aside from the tests that week, the children will continue with lessons such as Computing, Music, Discovery, PE etc. as timetabled.

Thursday 14 May 2026	Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning (40 minutes)


