Curriculum Overview

English - We practise writing skills daily and take our ideas from rich and varied texts including poetry and non-fiction. We continue to learn to write for different audiences and for different purposes. We aim to include as much ‘writing choice’ as possible.

Computing— We will be learning to touch type using a fun, engaging programme.



We will aim to maintain a fluent speed of typing by familiarity of the position of letters on the keyboard!

RE - We are learning about Sanātana Dharma through knowledge-based lessons and thoughtful reflections. We place a high value on building tolerance and understanding of different world faiths and cultures.

Reading - Through our quality reading lessons, we enjoy a wide variety of text types and always read aloud together, working on our fluency. Every lesson allows children the opportunity to show a clear understanding of the text they have read.

P.E- All children take part in lively and engaging, weekly PE lessons to develop their skills in Dance and Gymnastics, Sending and Receiving, Net and Wall and Passing and Space. This will be done through a variety of activities, including ball skills and co-operative games.

French - We will be learning to ask and answer simple questions by recalling words and phrases. Our main focus will be dates this half term.

P.S.H.E - Our weekly PSHE lessons this half term help us to celebrate and value our differences. We explore our thoughts and feelings with respect to our friends, families and communities.

Music - We are learning how to play and enjoy the wonderful sounds of the steel pans by developing a wide variety of rhythmic patterns.

Science: - Our topic is **FORCES!** We will learn that: a force is a push, a pull or a twist in a particular direction; magnets attract or repel each other; and objects move differently on different surfaces because of friction.



ART - Taking inspiration from our watery world, we shall investigate pattern to then create our own printing tile.

Geography - We are beginning to learn about the difference between climate and weather as well as the differing climate zones of the world.
