# Year 3 – Summer 1

## Curriculum Overview

**English** - We practise writing skills daily and take our ideas from rich and varied texts including poetry and non-fiction. We continue to learn to write for different audiences and for different purpose. We aim to include as much ‘writing choice’ as possible. We start with Shakespeare’s, ‘A Midsummer Night’s Dream’.

**Computing**— We will be learning how to keep ourselves and others safe online in our weekly lesson. We will also be learning how to code by following a progressive coding programme.



**RE**- We are going to explore People of God through Bible stories, art and song. During our weekly lessons, children will have the opportunity to learn about being respectful and tolerant of the beliefs and faith of others.

**Reading**—Through our quality reading lessons, we enjoy a wide variety of text types and always read aloud together, working on our fluency. Every lesson allows children the opportunity to show a clear understanding of the text they have read. We are going to enjoy some well-known Greek Myths, starting with King Midas.

**P.E**- All children take part in lively, engaging, weekly PE lessons to develop their skills in orienteering, fielding and striking and athletic skills. All lessons encourage children to practise and develop specific and transferable physical skills whilst learning that exercise is beneficial to our health and well-being.

**French**— We will be learning the vocabulary used to chat about where we live. Children are encouraged to use the French phrases learnt in class through hearing the words and through songs.

**P.S.H.E**— Our weekly PSHE lessons this half term help us to learn how to discuss and understand ‘Rights and Respect’.

**Music**— We are learning how to play and enjoy a recorder!

**Science**: We will be learning about the wonderful world of plants across the Summer Term. We learn the parts of a flowering plant, that we need key pollinators and exactly what plants need to thrive.

**Art**- We design and make a clay tile using inspiration from our wonderful natural world.

**History**- This half term, we are going to finding out about the Ancient Greek Civilisation through learning how to make observations from a variety of sources as well as understanding how modern-day life stems from some of the concepts the Ancient Greeks established.

**Geography** – This half term, we will be looking at the geography of the U.K., including how England is organised into counties and Poole’s location within the U.K.
