# Curriculum Overview

## Year 5 – Spring 2



### English

The first part of this half term's English learning will be writing a non-chronological report about a Victorian invention of their choice. After this, the children will be focussing on writing centred around Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo.

### Maths

All classes follow the National Curriculum and cover the Year 5 objectives throughout the year. Please see Maths overview for further details.



### Reading

In Reading lessons, children will read a selection of texts, based around our English and discovery learning, to develop inference, summary and prediction skills.

### RE

The Big Frieze - focusing on Salvation, the children will strengthen their understanding of Christianity.



### PHSE

PSHE this half term is focused on 'Keeping Safe.'

### French

This half term's French learning is closely focused around travel and transport.

### Computing

We continue to develop our coding skills through the use of code.org

### Music

Children will be building on skills and knowledge learnt in Years 3 and 4 with regard to steel pans.

### PE

In P.E 1 and P.E.2 this half term, the foci are: Net and wall, gymnastics, flag football, striking and fielding and athletics and leadership.

### Art

This half term's Art is focussed around the skill of sculpture (wire). The children will be using a selection of technical and design skills to produce a final piece of work linked with our Science topic.

### History

In History, we will be learning about the Victorians and the impact this era had on the world today.
