## Curriculum Overview

# Year 5 – Spring 1



### English

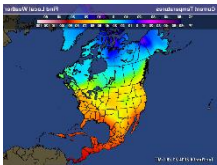
First, we will be focusing on writing a non-fiction text about a space rover. After the sci-fi, non-fiction writing, the pupils will be writing their own ending for a science fiction story. A variety of texts will be studied and used as a stimulus to promote this learning.

### Maths

All classes follow the National Curriculum and cover the Year 5 objectives throughout the year. Please see Maths overview for further details.

### Reading

In Reading lessons, children will read a selection of science-fiction texts to develop inference, summary and prediction skills.



### Geography

In Geography we will look at the impact of weather and climate in North America.

### RE

The Big Frieze - Focusing on Incarnation, the children will strengthen their understanding of Christianity.



### PSHE

PSHE this half term is focussed on 'Valuing difference'

### French

This half term's French learning is learning to talk about hobbies and pastimes. This will extend the work already done about sport.



### Science

An exciting study of the Earth and our Solar System makes up our Science topic. We will learn about how the Earth's position impacts life on Earth – day length, night and day and the seasons.

### Computing

Spring term in Computing is focused around coding. The children will all have a personalised learning journey through a coding programme, Code.org

### Music

Children will be developing their steel pan skills, fusing together some key movie themes.

### PE

In PE, children are developing their knowledge in gymnastics and net and wall-based activities. Alongside this, they are improving their sending & receiving of different objects, passing and space and creative dance.

### DT

This half term the children will be designing and making their own toy which will consist of a moving part in the form of a CAM.
