Curriculum Overview

English: - We will be studying the story of Beowulf and using it to support us in writing a non-chronological report and a narrative whilst looking closely at the key objectives to develop the children as writers.

Maths: - Please see separate overview for more detail.

Computing: - We will be continuing with our coding sessions and understanding the difficulty of translating real problems into programs. We will also experiment with communicating ideas through codes and symbols.



RE: - We will be learning about the life of Jesus in the run up to Easter.

Reading: - We will be continuing looking at a variety of texts including poetry and fairy tales and also practising our key skills to answer questions.



P.E.: - This term we are developing our spatial awareness and passing skills whilst thinking about communication. We are also learning about alternative physical education activities. In Games lessons, the children will be keeping fit using different genres of dance and gymnastics. Our swimming lessons also continue with 2 more of our classes attending these.

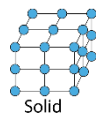
French: - We will be learning about different fruit and vegetables and saying whether we like them or not.



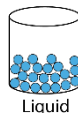
P.S.H.E.: - We will be investigating the ‘Health & Wellbeing’ unit of work, reflecting and discussing how to keep ourselves safe and healthy.

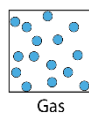
Science—We will be learning about states of matter through a variety of experiments.
