Key Knowledge

To know that:

A plan is important so you know how to achieve your desired outcome.

The purpose of a product needs to be shown in the design.

You need to secure the end of the thread before starting sewing.

Textiles can be shaped using templates.

A running stitch can be used to join two pieces of material.

To thread a needle, you pass the needle over the thread rather than push the thread through.

Other materials and objects can be used for decoration e.g. buttons, fabric pen



To know how:

Research

- To begin to research others' needs e.g. Why do people need specific products like egg cosies?

Design

- To develop my own design criteria through discussion, including both function and appearance.
- To create a plan which shows the order of making, equipment and tools, fit for purpose

Make

- To apply simple finishing techniques with some accuracy.
- To adapt a template to create a pattern and cut this out.
- To use one type of stitch to join two pieces of material.
- To thread a needle.

Evaluate

- To evaluate their product, considering: how well it has been made, materials used, whether it works, the making process used, if it is fit for purpose.

Key vocabulary:

- **Needle**—a fine piece of metal used to pierce the material.
- **Thread**—a thin piece of material.
- **Material**—such as felt and wool.
- **Egg cosies**—a small cover made of wool or other material and designed to be placed over a boiled egg to keep it warm
- **Product design**—creative process to create product.
- **Sewing**—the activity of making or mending clothes or other things using a needle and thread
- **Evaluate**—reflect on what went well and what you can improve in the future.
- **Stitch**: a loop of thread resulting from a single movement of the needle
