Key Knowledge: to know that...

Stories in the Bible teach us to put our faith in God— e.g. Noah, Abraham in hard times.

A Covenant is a two-way promise between a person and God.

Christians use Bible stories as a guide for their own lives today.

There are links between the story of Noah and the idea of covenant.

There are links between promises in the story of Noah and promises that Christians make.

There are links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world.

The story of Abraham and Isaac shows faith being tested.

Key Vocabulary:

Christians = A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity

Christianity = The religion based on the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Old Testament = The first part of the Bible.

Resurrection = When Jesus rose from the dead.

Pilgrimage = A journey to visit a religious site.

Miracles = Amazing events that God has done but cannot be explained.

Church = A building where Christians go to meet and worship.
