**Know that...**

## Key Vocabulary:

**Salvation:** being a saviour or rescuer of others: 'Jesus, our salvation'

**Easter:** the Holy time when Christians remember Jesus' death and resurrection

**Holy Week:** the last week of Jesus' life where key events happened

**Palm Sunday:** the Sunday before Easter, on which Christ's entry into

Jerusalem **Maundy Thursday:** the fifth day of Holy Week which

remembers the Last Supper. **Holy Communion:** the act of taking bread and wine to remind us of Jesus

**The Last Supper:** the last meal Jesus shared with his disciples

**Garden of Gethsemane:** the garden where Jesus was praying when he was arrested

**Jerusalem:** the Holy City for Christians where Jesus arrived on a donkey

**Disciples:** a follower of Jesus.

**Betrayal:** an act of deliberate disloyalty or breaking someone's trust.
