### Key Knowledge: to know that...

**Hindus/Sanatani have shrines in their homes and worship in Temples called Mandir.**

**Hindu/Sanatani worship is called 'Puja'.**

**The key Holy text is called the Bhagavad Gita. It is a guide for Hindus/Sanatani.**

### Other knowledge

Individual Gods have different roles and are worshipped for different reasons.

People worship Murti (Gods/Goddesses) using a Puja tray that holds special items.

People take a special pilgrimage journey to the River Ganges.



## Key Vocabulary:

Murti: Gods / Goddesses

Puja: The act of worship.

Shrine: A place where Murti (Gods or Goddesses) are worshipped.

Mandir: a Sanatani/Hindu Temple of worship. Temple: a place/building of worship.

Holi: A spring festival celebrated in honour of Krishna.
