We have been informed by a number of parents that our bulk emails are not landing in their inboxes. This is due to Microsoft (Hotmail/Outlook) and Gmail implementing strict, automated and AI-driven spam filters, which can mistakenly flag legitimate automated school emails as spam. In order to fix this issue please:



- 1. Mark as "Not Junk":** Parents should check their junk/spam folders, mark Arbor emails as "Not Junk," and move them to their inbox to "train" the filters.
- 2. Whitelist the Email Address:** Manually add no-reply@mail.arbor-education.com to the safe senders list.

We very much hope that this fixes the issue. Understandably, those affected by the issue may not receive this message, so please can the 'most organised member of each class WhatsApp groups' screen shot this message and post in the group. **Many thanks!**
