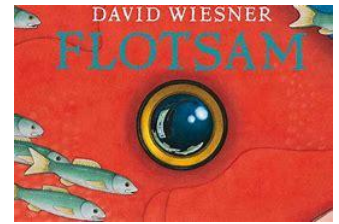

Curriculum Overview

English

This half term’s English is focused around ‘Flotsam’, a children’s wordless picture book written and illustrated by David Wiesner. The main task is to write a 1st person monologue based on images and ideas from the book.



Reading

In Reading lessons, children will read a selection of texts, based around our English and Discovery learning, to develop inference, summary, vocabulary and prediction skills.

Maths

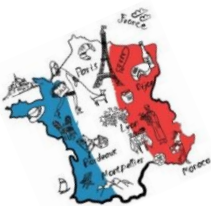
All classes follow the National Curriculum and cover the Year 5 objectives throughout the year. Please see Maths overview for further details.



PE

In P.E, we will be focusing on Striking & Fielding (leadership) and Tennis (sport education season).

French



This half term, we will be focusing on a presentation about ourselves to include and recap what we have learnt this year. We will also be reading some French stories and learning about some aspects of French life.

Music

This half term, we will be using a music package called Yustudio to compose a hip - hop piece.

Art



In Art this half term, we will be looking at local landscapes and particularly focusing on John Dimech who is a local artist that paints landscapes of the local area using acrylic and watercolours.



RE

This half term’s R.E is centred on Islam - learning about the key teachings of Islam and what it means to be a Muslim.

History

The history learning is focused around a local study of Poole and its surrounding areas. We learn about how our locality has been used and has changed throughout the periods of history studied.



PSHE

During this half-term, we learn about changes in our bodies and we discuss relationships.
