Poole was used as a trade port throughout history.

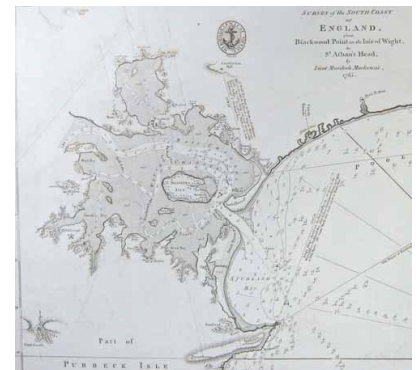


Poole Harbour was one of busiest ports during the 18th Century.
