### Key Knowledge:

#### To know that:

- A cognate is a French word which is the same or very similar to its English equivalent e.g. orange, bleu
- The spelling of colours is sometimes the same as English but the pronunciation is different
- 'C'est...' means 'It is...'
- 'C'est de quelle couleur?' means 'What colour is it?'
- French people use rising intonation to make a question
- Letters on the end of French words are often silent—vert, violet, c'est
- Christmas traditions in France are different - Christmas Eve is the most important day of the season.
