We are also celebrating [Glenmoor & Winton Academy](#), who will introduce a smartphone-free, brick-only policy for their new Year 7 students from September 2026 🎉. A massive thank you to all the Headteachers involved for their leadership and commitment to student wellbeing. WE DID IT, TOGETHER! 🙌

In even bigger news, the [Prime Minister](#) just announced plans to ban social media for under-16s in the UK. This is a phenomenal victory for our children and future generations. This historic moment simply would not have happened without the hundreds of thousands of parents of SFC who spoke up, organised, and refused to accept the status quo.

Today is a powerful reminder that real change is possible when ordinary people come together. We will share more details soon about what this national policy means and why the next stage of Smartphone Free Childhood is more critical than ever.
