RLSS Poole Lifeguard is a not-for-profit charity dedicated to teaching lifesaving skills, first aid, CPR, and water safety to young people and the wider community. Their volunteer members also provide safety cover at open-water events throughout the year — all in their own spare time. The club has been saving lives since 1975.

With the recent lovely spell of hot weather, they have been deeply troubled to read a [BBC News report](#) stating that nine people have lost their lives in open water since Sunday, including seven teenagers, some as young as nine years old. These tragedies are heartbreaking and they are preventable.

This raises an important question: **Are we doing enough — as parents, families, schools, workplaces, and communities — to promote water safety, especially during hot weather?**

Many young people do not fully understand the dangers of open water, including:

- Cold water shock
- Hidden currents
- Sudden depth changes
- Entrapment hazards
- The effects of exhaustion and panic
