Key Knowledge: to know that...

God the Son is the physical being of Jesus, who was sent to Earth to save us and bring people closer to God.

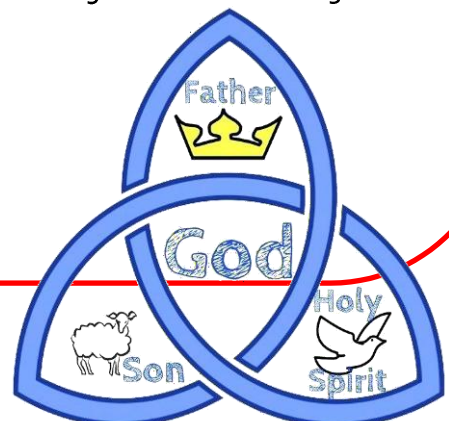
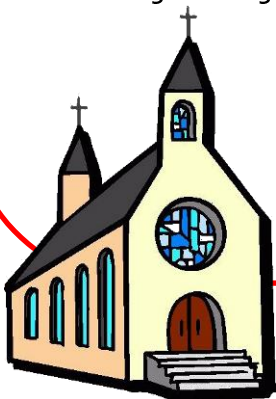
God the Holy Spirit is God's powerful essence that is inside all of us and helps to connect us to God.

Key Vocabulary:

Holy Trinity - God represented in three special parts: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

God the Father - God in Heaven who created the Earth and everything in it.

God the Son - is the physical being of Jesus, who was sent to Earth to save us and bring people closer to God.

God the Holy Spirit - God's powerful essence that is inside all of us and helps to connect us to God.

Big Story - the story map of the Bible that shows the key events in order.

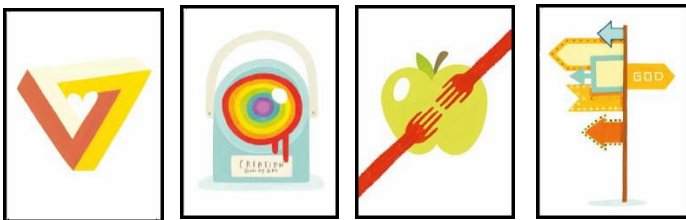
Bible - the Christian Holy book that has the story and all of God's teachings. **Frieze panels** - the big pictures of the story that show the key events
