**Reminder: it is back to school uniform for the last 3 days of term!
(normal PE kit for normal PE days)**

To help families cope with holiday costs, the Government's **Great British Summer Savings scheme** is cutting VAT from 20% to 5% on children's meals, entertainment tickets and attractions between 25 June and 1 September 2026.

This discount combines with free August bus travel in England for children aged 5 to 15 to make summer experiences more affordable.

If you get into trouble in the water, Float to Live!

Tilt your head back with ears submerged

2



Relax and try to control your breathing

3



Move your hands & legs to help you stay a float

4



It's okay if your legs sink, we all float differently

5



Spread your arms and legs to improve stability

FLAGS



(Black/White Flag)

This area is for water-sports like windsurfing and surfing, kayaks & paddleboards.



(Red/Yellow Flag)

This is a lifeguarded area. This is the safest area to swim or bodyboard.



(Red Flag)

This means danger. NEVER go into the sea where this flag is flying.



(Orange Flag)

Indicates offshore or strong wind conditions. Never use inflatables when it's flying.

SIGNS



(SIGN 1)

This sign means do not use inflatables. It's unsafe in strong winds.



(SIGN 2)

This sign means beware of rip currents in this area. They can drag you out of your depth.



(SIGN 3)

This sign means beware of the tide. You could get cut off when the tide comes in.
